**GENESIS OF ST. JOSEPH'S COLLEGE**

The Archdiocese of Hyderabad established a separate Educational Society in 1983 under the banner of HAES which has 24 institutions including St. Joseph's Degree and PG College and St. Joseph's PG College with AICTE approved courses; the vision and mission of the college- “To

Provide a distinct environment of excellence in education with humane values and social commitment in offering quality education”.

Most Rev. Dr. S. Arulappa, the then Archbishop of Hyderabad blessed the building and Prof. Rama Kistaiah, then, Vice-chancellor of Osmania University inaugurated the college on 10 July 1997. Late Most Rev. M. Joji, the then Archbishop of Hyderabad during his tenure from 2000-2010 was a real inspiration to the institution in seeking permanent affiliation, NAAC accreditation and finally entering into Autonomy status. Currently, the college gets orientation and guidance from **Most Rev. Thumma Bala DD.**, present Archbishop of Hyderabad and the Chairperson of the Society, who is well known for his vision and simplicity. Rev.Fr.Dr.V.K.Swamy is the founder Principal and continues to lead the institution to greater heights **to explore, to enhance, to excel and to enrich.**

I am sure, dear students and staff, you are familiar with the five Core Values of josephites- *Trust in Divinity, Foster Integrity, Acquire Competencies, Strive for Excellence and Serve the Society*; and the entire gamut of operations in this institution are woven with these 5 threads of Core values. It brings waves of emotions when I take you down the memory lane...a journey - an education yatra - that began with 134 students in 1997 to pursue 3 UG courses- (one in B. Sc (MPCs) and two streams in B.Com). Today we have over 1800 students pursuing 13 UG and 4 PG courses. The academic reputation and infrastructure growth, introduction of new courses indicate a continuous journey beyond the threshold of mediocrity to soar into an ever continuing explorative experience in quality education.

This is the reason we provide a distinct environment and encourage the students to think out of the box and be creative in all their activities, through our committed and qualified faculty.

being 3<sup>rd</sup> Rank in Hyderabad & ALL INDIA 44<sup>th</sup> Rank as BEST COMMERCE COLLEGE by India Today magazine - June 18, 2012. The Business Management program is 97<sup>th</sup> best all India, 8<sup>th</sup> in AP and 76<sup>th</sup> perceptual rank (Business Today).

**AUTONOMY- PROGRESS:** UGC Sanctioned two seminars (National and International) & Two certificate courses under Career oriented Programmes for the academic year 2012-13. The Principal and Mr. Praveen presented our document in New Delhi for the need of Career Oriented Programs in UGC office which would help our students to have value addition courses in Science and Commerce & Management.

Every year the College conducts Board of studies meeting on various subjects to update the curriculum. The Academic Council which held on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2012 with the university nominees and experts from the Industry approved the curriculum and the Governing Body which includes the Government, UGC and the University nominees held on 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2012 validated the progress of the institution after the introduction of Autonomy.

## **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE:**

The pass percentage of results for B Com and B.Sc were 96% and 60% and MBA & MCA were 98% and 100%.

**Proud Moment:** Ms Nikita Singh of MBA was awarded the Gold Medal at OU for securing highest marks in MBA at OU in 2012 and she will be awarded gold medal shortly during the celebration. This is the second time St. Joseph's College gets Gold Medal in the University for the MBA program.

Apart from these prizes, the College management encourages by awarding Rs.1000 for the students who secures 85%+in optional subjects in the University exams. This year, 17 students will be receiving the cash award of Rs.1000 for securing 85%+ marks and 31 students for achieving centum (100%) marks in any one subject.

Prabhakar Reddy, Reader, Badurka College of Commerce in memory of his father M.VeeraVenkat Reddy, Impact Education, Director B.R.Singh, Mr. C. Chandra Shekararan Nair in memory of his late son C.Vaishak of B.Com (Hons, 2008-11), Mr. Michael Raj, in memory of his mother Smt. Adaikalammal, Mrs. Suguna Sheela, faculty and Dr. S. Brinda, Dean, St. Joseph's College(2 gold medals). We thank the sponsors and others are also requested to emulate them in recognizing the merit students in memory of your dear and near ones.

## **EDUCATION PROCESS @ ST. JOSEPH'S**

In a decade and a half, the college has made a phenomenal progress and established a well-deserved reputation in academics and all the other areas like sports, co curricular and cultural activities. At St. Joseph's we prepare young students into Leaders for real life with talents, responsibility, and above all nation builders who cherish humane and moral values. The College lays a strong emphasis on social and spiritual values moulding them into caring, sharing and responsible human beings and lifelong learners.

## **STUDENT SUPPORT PROGRAMS**

1. **Induction Programmes:** The college conducted course wise induction programs(UG & PG exclusively) for the freshers. During this academic year the College introduced an **Interface Day with parents and students of I st year UG** on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2012 **to know their expectations** with Prof Jayaprakash Rao, Chairman, APSCHE as the Chief Guest.

2. **Entry Level Tests:** Entry level English Language Skills Test - 2012 was conducted by the English Department for all the students of I year on 11 July 2012 and on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2012 for the Management students. Those who were not successful, they were given special coaching for 30 hours and once again they were tested in the language proficiency. Numerical ability test was conducted for MBA I year students on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2012.

3. **Bridge Courses & Certificate courses:** The English and Management Departments conducted five Bridge Courses which aimed at homogenizing the student group. The students are trained in employability skills through 17 certificate courses providing skill and career enhancement by various departments. The students have to secure minimum 2 credits at the end of 4<sup>th</sup> semester which is accounted for the final results.

4. **Club / Cell Activities:** To enhance academic attainments an environment is built through academic clubs.

5. **Guest Lectures:** Every department organizes guest lectures on various topics so that the students get the knowledge by listening to the experts and give exposure beyond their curriculum. We had one international guest lecture by Prof Ravi Seethamraju, University of Sydney and 26 guest lectures for UG & PG.

6. **Hands on Experience/Industrial Visits:** A total of seven industry/field visits were organised by the concerned departments to provide experiential learning and industry exposure. The outbound training program of BBA was held on 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup> Feb 2013 by Rev.Fr.Dr.Divya Paul, Dean, Dept of Psychology and Counseling Sampurna-Montfort College, Bangalore. A Computer Fair was conducted on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2012 for I year B.Com (Gen), B.Com (Comp), B.Com (Hons), B.B.A, B.Sc students.

7. **Entrepreneurship Development Cell Activities:** Two day long programs in collaboration with NSIC(National Small Industries Corporation Ltd) and Micro-Small and Medium Enterprise(MSME) were organised on 22<sup>nd</sup> August and 8<sup>th</sup> October 2012.

## **8. Students' Mega Events 2012:**

a. **Film Festival:** Department of Mass Communication & Journalism organized a film festival called "CinEvolution - Best in the World" on 15th and 16th of September 2012. Popular Telugu film hero, Manchu Manoj Kumar and upcoming hero Navdeep were part of the valedictory ceremony. Roadies fame Vinay Abhishek and Taranjeet Kaur and few other prominent personnel from the media fraternity were a major attraction at the film festival. The event attracted 14 short films of 10 minutes duration each. Prominent TV producer and the president of APTV Chamber of Commerce Mr. Nagabala Suresh Kumar were also present.

b. **JOSEPHIESTA 2012-** A Culmination of Talents!: both academic and cultural was held on 19<sup>th</sup> - 20<sup>th</sup> December 2012. As an advertising strategy for Josephiesta, the Flash Mob was performed an energetic and vibrant dance number at the City Centre, Punjagutta. Prof.T.L.N. Swamy, Principal of Nizam College declared the event open. About 3500 students from 90 colleges across the twin cities showcased an amazing array of talents. The Fest comprised of nearly 50 formal and informal events to bring to fore the various dormant potential of students. Msgr. Swarna Bernard, VG & Vice Chairman HAES, was the Chief Guest for the valedictory function.

## **9. Other Events/Celebrations:**

Bio Diversity Day, International Girl Child Day (11<sup>th</sup> October 2012), 66th Independence Day and Christmas Celebrations were celebrated with lot of enthusiasm.

## **10. IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell):**

The internal quality assurance Cell, which is constituted under the Chairmanship of the Principal in June 2009, organised NAAC sponsored seminar on 25th and 26th of September 2012 in the College premises on the "**Role of IQAC - Sustenance and Enhancement of Quality in HEIs**". Prof.V.S.Prasad, former Director, NAAC, was the Chief Guest for the inaugural, Dr.G.Sriinivas, Joint Secretary, UGC-SERO was the Guest of Honor, and Shri S. Abhirama Krishna, Director, SSB School, Hyderabad, was the Chief Guest for the Valedictory and many more reputed resource persons delivered their talk. As many as 100 research scholars from various parts of India had participated and presented their views. The organizing committee received 56 abstracts and 49 full papers. 27 Faculty members of St. Joseph's Degree & PG College also presented papers.

#### 11. PLACEMENT RECORD:

The excellent academic records of the students do not end with the results. I am pleased to inform the gathering nearly 90 students from various streams are placed by 16 companies from Amazon, Igate, Deloitte, E-Boss, GE(Cap), HSBC, Cognizant, NTT Data GDS, Cognizant (BPO), Apollo Health Street, WIPRO(WiSTA), Virtusa, Franklin Tempelton , Genpact, Fact set and UBS. Two students were placed with highest package of **Rs 3,15,000** by UBS in job fair conducted at Dr. B.R.Ambedkar College. The management is grateful to Dr. Vidya sagar and other faculty who are associated with the placement activities. I want to place it on record that the College can always facilitate placements but we cannot find employment for the students who are not employable. This is the main reason, the college organizes number of add on courses and certificate courses. The students are asked to make use of the certificate courses which are thoroughly subsidized.

**Internships:** 15 students were provided internships by Amazon.com and Indian Bank for B.Com and MBA students.

**Pre- placement activities:** The College conducts regularly pre placement activities to enhance the students' employability skills.

**FACULTY:** The backbone of St. Joseph's Degree & PG College is her faculty. The college has 68 well qualified and dedicated teaching faculty, 48 non- teaching, technical and support staff. I am very happy to work with my talented team and I am grateful to their contribution towards excellence; Prof. K. Malla Reddy as PG Director, Rev. Fr. Dominic Savio as Vice Principal, Mr. Praveen Kumar, Academic Secretary, Dr. Vidaya Sagar, Placement officer, Prof. Sharma, Dean of Science, Dr. Brinda, Dean of Arts, Rev. Fr. Kingston SVD, HoD of Mass Communication & Journalism, Dr. Deepika Gardener, HoD, English, Mrs. Vinya Sheela, HoD, Commerce, Mrs. Priya, HoD, Science, Mr. Srinivas Reddy, HoD, Maths& Stats, Mrs. R. Anita, HoD, Management, Mr. Joseph Rajkumar, HoD, Computer Science. We are proud to acknowledge 15 staff

members of the college are pursuing their Research degree in various Universities. It is because of their effort and dedication, the college has reputation and the management is ever grateful to them and I personally enjoy working with them.

#### **FACULTY DEVELOPMENT:**

Hence, every year some faculty members are sent for a proper orientation/ refresher courses. Mrs. Vinaya Sheela and Mrs. Srilatha attended one month Orientation program in Academic Staff College, Hyderabad Central University. Mr. Krishna Murthy and Mrs. SriLaxmi from the department of Commerce are undergoing the orientation program from 1 st March in the same place. The faculty of St. Joseph's attended the valedictory of the 24th AIMS (Association of Indian Management Schools) **Annual Management Education Convention 2012** held at the Mahindra Satyam premises on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August, 2012.

Rev.Fr.Dr.V.K.Swamy was awarded Ph. D in Business Management on 7<sup>th</sup> Feb 2013 during the 79<sup>th</sup> Convocation of Osmania University.

8 books and 5 papers were published by faculty. 10 faculty presented paper in various national and international seminars. 24 faculty attended seminar/workshops/conferences. 4 faculty attended refreshers courses. 5 faculty were resource persons for various events.

## **OUTREACH PROGRAMMES/ SOCIAL COMMITMENT**

St. Joseph's College is proud to say that all her Josephites imbibe the spirit of humane values and social concern by serving/visiting the less fortunate ones like Home for the Aged, Home for the Disabled, Aids center etc.,. The College has also extended help in providing 5 computers to St. Andrew's School, Siddhipet, Nizamabad dt and furniture to Infant Jesus School, Balaji Nagar, Yapral.
