International Guest Lecture by Dr. M. Krishna Erramili from USA

Entrepreneurship Development Cell organized a guest lecture for the registered students on 22nd January 2016. The resource person was Dr. Krishna Erramili, Associate Dean, and Professor of Marketing at the Stuart School of Business, Chicago, USA. He said that there is great demand for commerce stream and explained about the importance of Business Models with illustrations. He mentioned about the dynamic leadership of Mr. Steve Jobs and how the Apple Company has become a market leader in introducing innovative products such as I-Pad, I-Phone, Tablet etc. He explained about rural marketing where 'Go rural' is the marketer's new slogan. Indian marketers as well as multinationals, such as Godrej and Hindustan Lever etc have focused on rural markets. He also mentioned about "Chotukool", a tiny refrigerator launched by Godrej where Small shop keepers in rural areas who cannot afford regular fridges can be much benefitted. Dr. Krishna informed students about B-Schools in Chicago and also gave them tips to pursue studies in abroad.
