4 Seminar on Accessories Designing

The Dignitaries were Ms.Hema Yuvaraj, Head, Department of Accessories Design and Ms.Falguni, Senior Faculty, Department of Accessories Design, Hamstech Institute of Fashion and Interior Designing, Hyderabad. Ms. Hema Yuvraj said that Accessory designing is a growing career choice creating substantial employment opportunities. She said that Accessories Designing graduates have been able to carve a niche for themselves in traditional as well as emerging sectors of global fashion industry space namely jewellery, body gears, home accessories, craft, furniture, footwear, bag, interiors, and in the realm of Designing experiences. They have also been able to tap the potential of emerging markets such as User Interface and Experience design, smart wearables, Consumer interface design, product design and online market channels. Many Accessory Design graduates are successful fashion consultants and entrepreneurs today. She stated that certificate in Accessory Designing from Hamstech will give an opportunity to students to attend 2 weeks workshop at Government Institute of Leather Technology, Hyderabad.
