

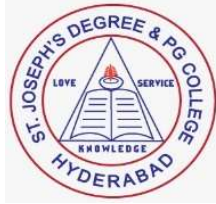

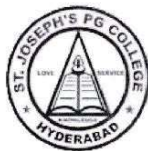


WOMEN EMPOWERMENT CELL

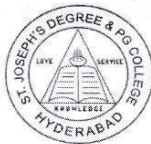
