



The department consists of two Ph.D.s, Dr. Mohd Irfan (Arabic) and Dr. T.P. Singh / Dr. Sadique Pasha (Hindi). The other faculty members are Mrs. Padmasri (French) HoD, Mrs. Aparna Rajhans (Sanskrit) & Mrs. Regina (Telugu).





The visit began on Thursday, 18th July 2019, from St. Joseph's college. There were 3 buses to escort all 125 students and 4 faculty members. There was a short prayer in the college before embarking on the trip. The trip was organized by Joseph's Green Group. The location of the school is in the district of Chevella which is at a good distance of 56 kilometers and the time taken for the journey was approximately 2 hours.

The students and faculty members reached the active farm school at around 10:30 AM and were served nutritious breakfast which comprised of *khichdi*, bread and jam and cornflakes along with milk.

The instructor briefed everyone about agriculture and its relation with entrepreneurship and demonstrated the process of planting seeds properly and familiarized everyone with the jargons involved in agricultural field. The students were divided into 4 groups and every group was assigned an activity. The activities involved serving food to the domestic animals, sowing seeds, experiencing a tractor-ride, preparation of bio enzymes and a special solution to enhance the growth of plants.

Working in the rice field was a different experience altogether, significantly different from anything one would have to do in the city, it really helped to develop an insight on how much effort goes into one plate of food, at the same time it reminded everyone about why the protection of the environment is so important and how one should be more responsible in one's approach towards the environment. A few games like gillidanda were conducted for all played few games in the open and later a delicious lunch

was served. The activities were filled with fun and knowledge, they were taught by the farmers in a very friendly and helpful manner. Over-all it was a great learning experience for the students.

At around 4 PM the students and faculty members bid adieu to the villagers and left the active farm school. Before leaving, everyone were handed bags of manure and soil to take it home and to try out planting activities on their own. The whole experience was absolutely brilliant and increased everyone's practical knowledge about agriculture and changed everyone's perspective about how life is in farms. Everyone thoroughly enjoyed the excursion and the general consensus is that everyone should have an activity like this as it helps to gel students up with the environment.


A total of 90 students were present for the session.



The Guest Speaker of the day was Dr. D. Narsing Rao Sir & the Topic was "**Holistic Development Through Language Learning.**"


Dr. Saadiq Pasta, Assistant Professor in Hindi, introduced the speaker.
