Seven participants made it to the final round. They are :-

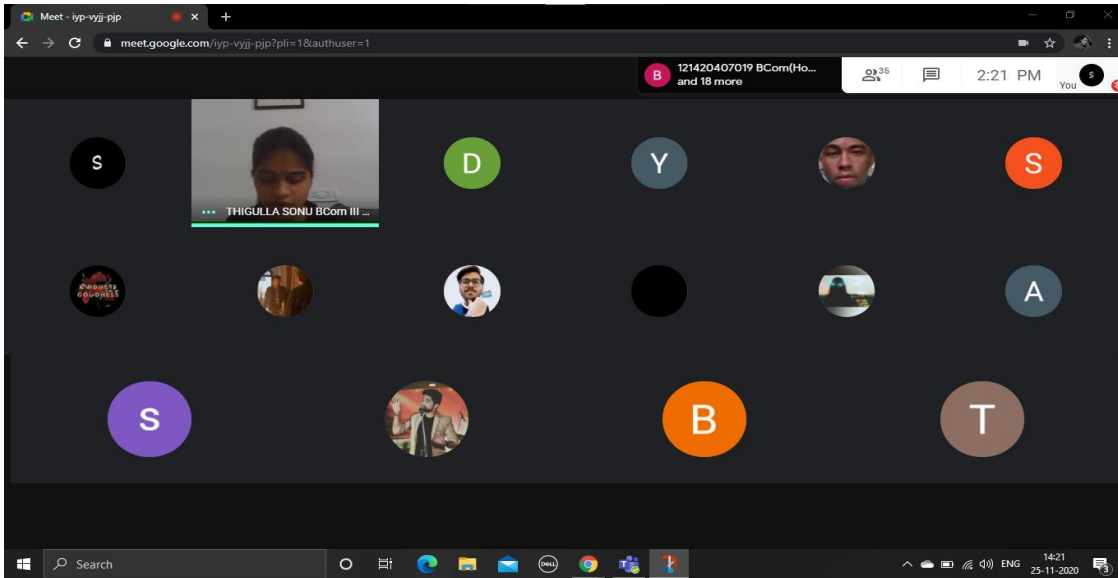

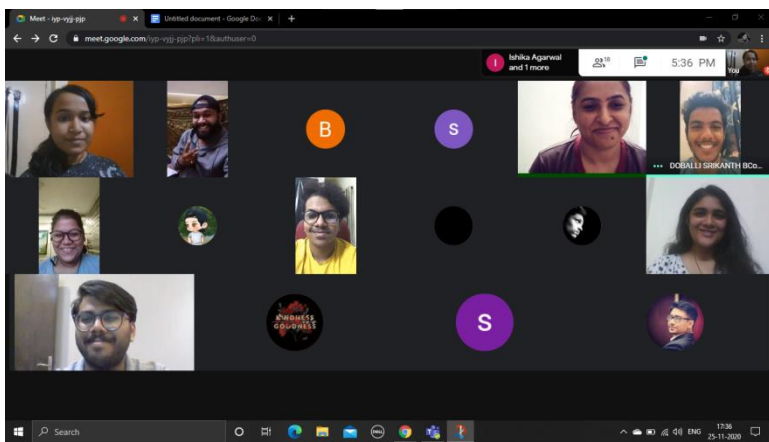
