On 23rd December 2021, students of BSc as a part of Josephite's Social Responsibility (JSR) and under the supervision of JSR convenor Mrs. S.Vijayalaxmi and faculty coordinator Mrs. J. Harika conducted a Blanket Drive at Divya Jyothi Foundation, Malakpet. After several days of planning and discussing this place was selected.

Some of the blankets were distributed to the poor people on the road side.




Report on Blanket Distribution Drive-B.Com
