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PROCEDURE & INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

1. The number of students will be divided into 2 batches.
2. Each Batch will be given with a Google Meet Link to join the exam.
3. Each Batch will have an Invigilator to monitor the students while writing exams.
4. The Question Paper will be shared through class Whatsapp group at sharp 9.00 AM.
5. The students should download the question paper and start writing on A4 Papers (in the prescribed format only) with neat margins and fill all the required details.
6. A Google Form link will be shared to all the students to upload the scanned copy (PDF Only) of the total answer scripts with the file name as student roll number and subject name. For example, "121421094001-TFS".
7. The Google form will be active between 10.00am to 10.30am to upload the answer scripts.
8. After the above timings, the Google forms will be deactivated and the students who fail to upload their answers scripts will not be allowed to submit further.
9. If any of the student is found and booked under malpractice case by the invigilator, that student will not be allowed to write that exam and even for the remaining exams.
10. The student should choose a place to write the exam with no disturbances and no other persons in the nearby.
11. The students should switch on their VIDEO in the Google Meet throughout the exam.
12. The student has to take care of the technical problems like power failure; internet connectivity issues should not affect the examination.
13. No Re-examination will be conducted, if you miss the exam with no reason.


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
