



The main objective of this programme is to discuss various initiatives undertaken and discussions on various thrust areas related to promotion of innovation and entrepreneurship in the country. Inaugural session was started at 10.30 am with Welcome address given by Chairman, Prof. Anil Sahasrabudhe, AICTE. In order to make India "EK BHARAT SHRESTA BHARAT" it is necessary to create a platform where student's innovative ideas can be depicted and further can be manufactured and commercialized. Manthan Hackathon is conducted, first of its kind which is mainly meant to focus on national security and extensive artificial intelligence usage in law enforcement agencies. Many teams used this platform by participating in different rounds and at the end, grand finale was conducted. Winners of this Manthan Hackathon were announced and appreciated.

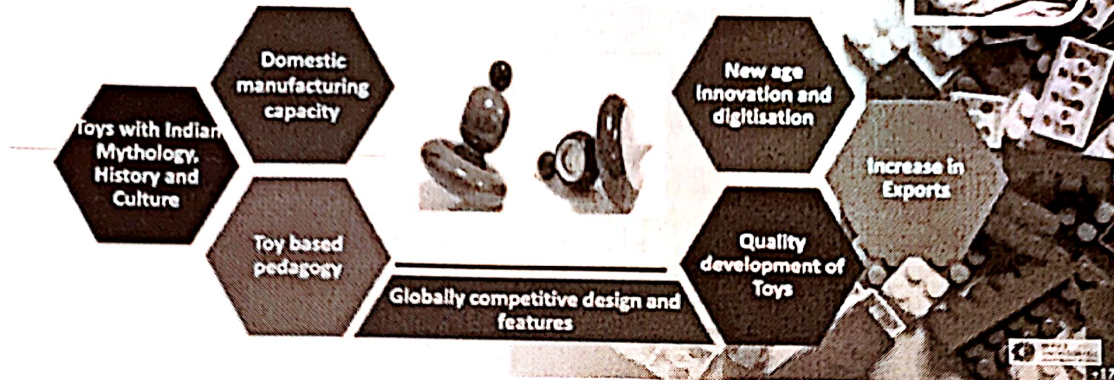

In the afternoon session Sri Sridhar Vembu, Founder , ZOH0 Corporation gave keynote address. He said there are 800 districts in India, most of it being rural, one has to spread the culture of Innovation and Entrepreneurs across the country. Structure of the education has to be changed in such a way that entrepreneurial skills are developed. Addressing the youth, he said, Start doing simple things, pull up the sleeves and really do something like building apps, building website, building games. He also stated that working in teams is very important.

At 2.00pm Panel Discussion 1 on Innovation, Human values and sustainability was conducted. Shri Harshit Rathore, Co-Founder & CTO, Naccarrc Robotics started his discussion by clearly defining invention and innovation. In his words, innovation refers to practical implementation of the idea that results in new product or survey. He gave some examples to clearly explain the difference between invention and innovation. Shri Vikash Mittersain, Founder & Managing Director. Nazara Technologies said that its high time now India should focus more on R&D. some system must be brought in which recognises innovations. R&D is on focussed in India. One has to be original in thinking. Shri Shrikanth Badve, M.D. Badve Industries said that innovations should become part of life. With basic intelligence one can go for innovation. India people have logical thinking with which innovation is possible. R & D is not required. The discussion continued with variant views expressed by the panelists.

At 3.30 pm Shri Gautam, founder ,FarEyePvt. Ltd gave a key note address. He said one has to focus on customer. His tastes and fashions. And creat a product to solve problems of customers. That is the key for success.

At 4.00pm panel discussion II was held on Best Innovations and Startup Practices in Higher Education Institutions. Prof Abay Karandikar, Director, IIT Kanpur told about the flow of how incubation centers helped the company and government participation further channelised the produce into global products

For success of startups, the key requirements are identified as: 1. A strong mentorship programme. 2. Availability of expert task force. 3. Readily available market. 4. Speed of execution and focus on results. Prof. Anirudha Pandey spoke on the objectives of higher education institutions and also in ICT initiatives which produced first generation entrepreneurs. Alumni also plays key role in bringing out innovative ideas. Sri Rahul Nayar, vice President, Invest India said that there are three reasons why corporations spend on innovations at Higher Education Institutions. They do it to be a part of the future. They do it to commercialise their product and thirdly, derisking as money is going into safe hands. Shri Rajendra Ratnoo, Js, DPIIT spoke about the importance of IPR and how start-ups should plan and focus on getting patents. How innovative design is to be protected. Innovators should know about all legal aspects so that they don't fall into any infringements and legal problems. Start-ups should know how to protect their IPRs. Finally, the session ended with lot of inputs which are beneficial to the budding entrepreneurs.
