Report:

Department of Commerce organised workshop on “Research Skills” for the faculty from 28th June to 3rd August 2018. The inaugural session was held on 28th June 2018 in Chapel Hall. The Dignitaries were Mr.Uday Bhate, Founder-Partner, Nmore, Secunderabad; Rev Fr. Prof.VincentArokiadas, Principal and Prof.P.L.Vishweshwar Rao, Director. Miss.M.Prashanthi from Department of Commerce welcomed the Dignitaries on to the dais for lighting of the lamp. Mrs.N.Srilatha, Head, Department of Commerce introduced the guest to the gathering.

Rev Fr. Dr.VincentArokiadas in his address urged the faculty to learn to focus and be a continuous learner. He said that the workshop would help the faculty in enhancing the ability and capacity to make a serious methodological study while pursuing PhD. Prof.P.L.Vishweshwar Rao stated that many changes have taken place in the economy after GST and it is necessary to analyse these changes. Data Science and Analytics are very important since there are different types of markets in India and hence research becomes essential. He said that teaching and research go together and learning is a continuous process. He wished the faculty to become rigorous research methodologist.

On 28th and 30th June 2018, Mr. Uday gave an insight on theoretical aspects relating to research such as Research Process, Defining the Problem, Hypothesis, Research Design and Research Methods. Around 18 practical sessions on SPSS were conducted in computer lab from 2nd July to 3rd August 2018 covering various topics such as First level Techniques which comprised of Frequencies, Cross Tabulation, Second Level Techniques which includes Hierarchical Clustering, K Means Clustering, Factor Analysis, Discriminant Analysis and other aspects. Faculty were asked to prepare DNA of their respective research topic covering aspects such as Need for research, Research Problem and Research Objectives and also design a Questionnaire to collect primary data for the research topic selected. Practical exercises were also given to faculty for solving. The workshop enabled the faculty to gain knowledge in both theoretical

aspects and practical applicability of SPSS. All faculty from all departments were benefited from the program.

Objective:

- To train the faculty in learning research methodology
- To demonstrate and give hands-on for learning statistical tool SPSS

Outcome:

Faculty were able to understand the flavor of research methodologies and the relative tools in analyzing the data. Hands on session on SPSS were a great move towards the analysis of large data.




