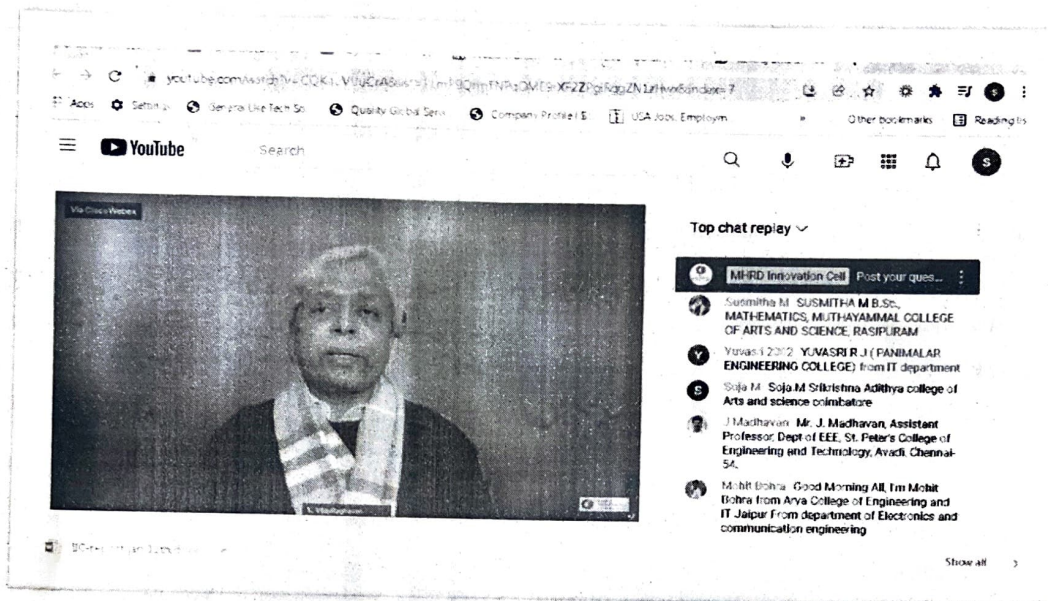

Keynote Address – III: Address by Prof. Vijay Raghavan, PSA, Govt. of India.

The speaker Prof K. Vijay Raghavan, Principal Scientific Advisor (PSA) to the Government of India, addressed audience by making an important point that “what are we doing today in the context of innovation and entrepreneurship, where we came from recently and where we should go later?” He also stressed a note that any given time innovation and entrepreneurship depends enormously on the state of the fundamentals of the eco system, R&D laboratories, School and College education, and research in that system. Professor K. Vijay Raghavan, also emphasized on need of innovation for economic change and sustainability. He said that we need to expand the funding of research and innovation eco-system to position India as a favoured destination for Research and Development. He highlighted on adoption of best global practices for establishing closer linkages with national R&D institutions and academia, talent development and sourcing, strategic partnerships to bolster R&D in India and integrating with the domestic start-up ecosystem. He further added that, innovation must be linked with economic change and market and in synchronization with ongoing policy measures including Swachh Bharat, Made in India etc. etc. He urged Indian youth to come forward in sharing the ideas for country and economic development.

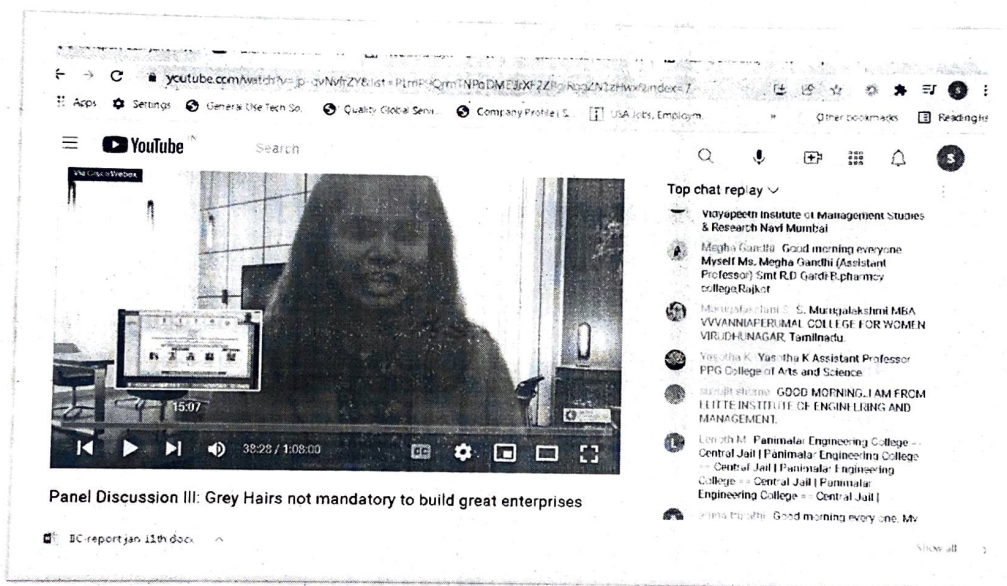

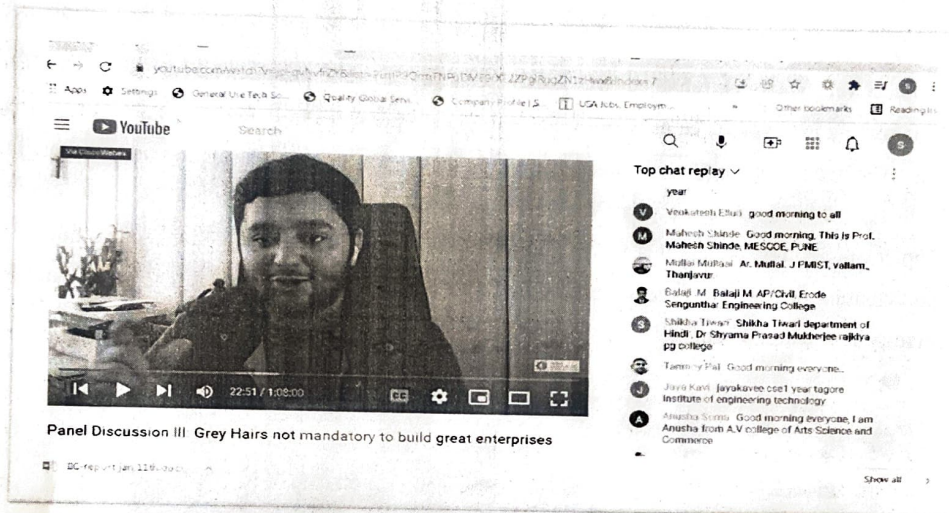
innovators & entrepreneurs in their early stage of venture and shared their perspectives on innovation and entrepreneurship career journeys.

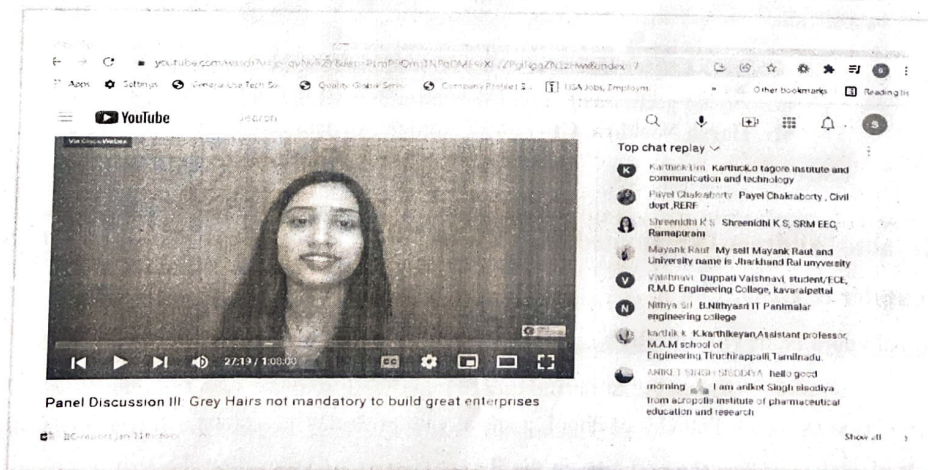
Ms Shefali Founder & COO of PS-1925

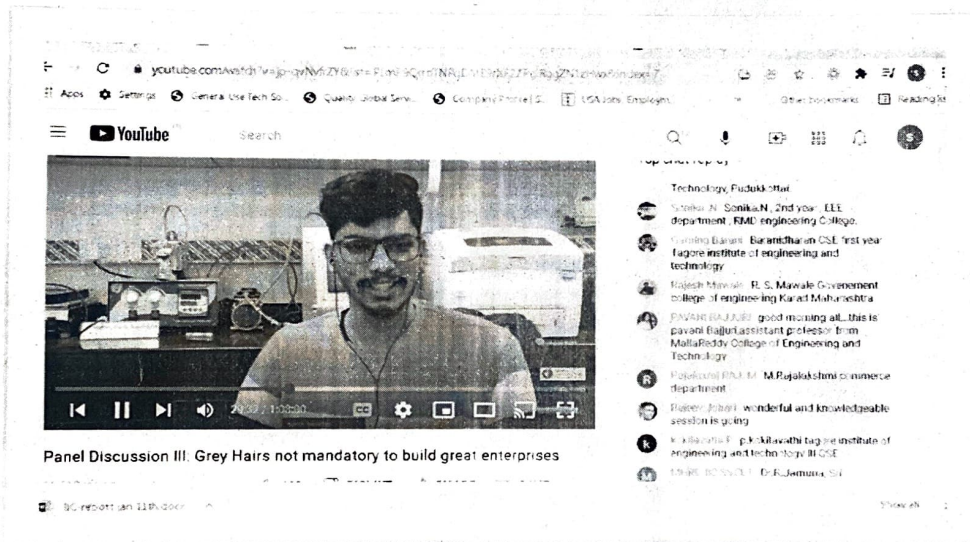

Ankit Agarwal is the Founder of Phool, a social enterprise that has pioneered 'flower cycling' technologies to reduce the pollution in the Rivers Ganges by up-cycling the vast quantities of flower temple-waste in India. Every year, more than eight million metric tons of pesticide-laden

temple-flowers are dumped in the Ganges, choking the river and causing severe health concerns like diarrhea, hepatitis and cholera. At Phool, over 8.4 tons of temple-waste is collected daily in Uttar Pradesh and converted into charcoal-free incense and an animal-free alternate to leather called Fleather. He shared how he became an innovator and entrepreneur with one slipping point in the discussion, and he also shared that eco-friendly solutions to our nature challenges are very much required. He spoke about how his graduation projects, paper presentations motivated him or helped him to achieve his goal.

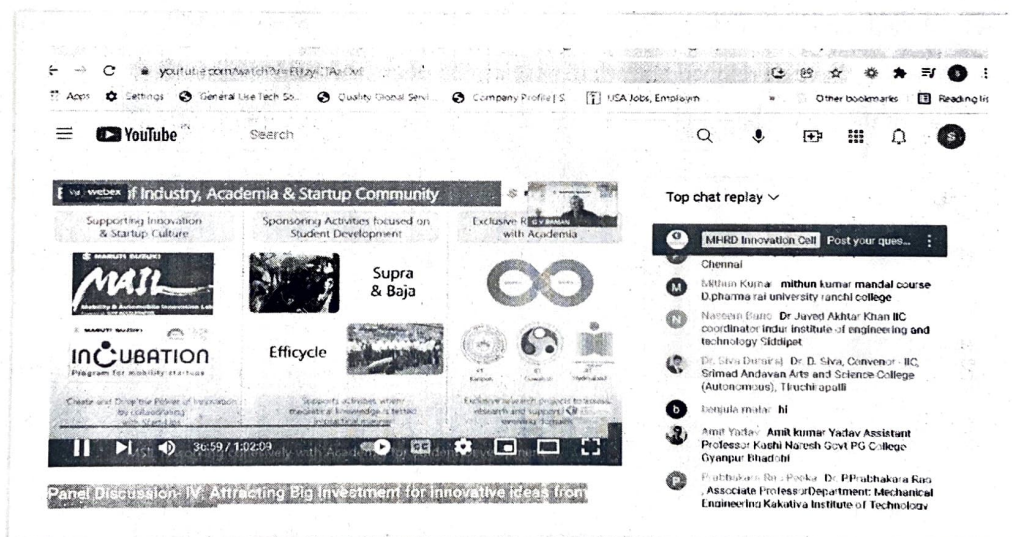
