Objective of the visit: The main objective of this industrial visit is to provide the students an insight regarding actual practices carried out at NIRD mainly meant in promoting sustainable livelihood and entrepreneurship among people from rural areas. NIRD provides functional live demonstrations and functional exposure to replicate models to meet location specific contextual needs.

Outcome of the visit: Students had a very good exposure understanding the sustainable and cost effective housing models, sanitation park, water harvesting structures and water and wastewater resource center, Biogas plant, vermi composting units, solar and hybrid technology solutions and various technology units.

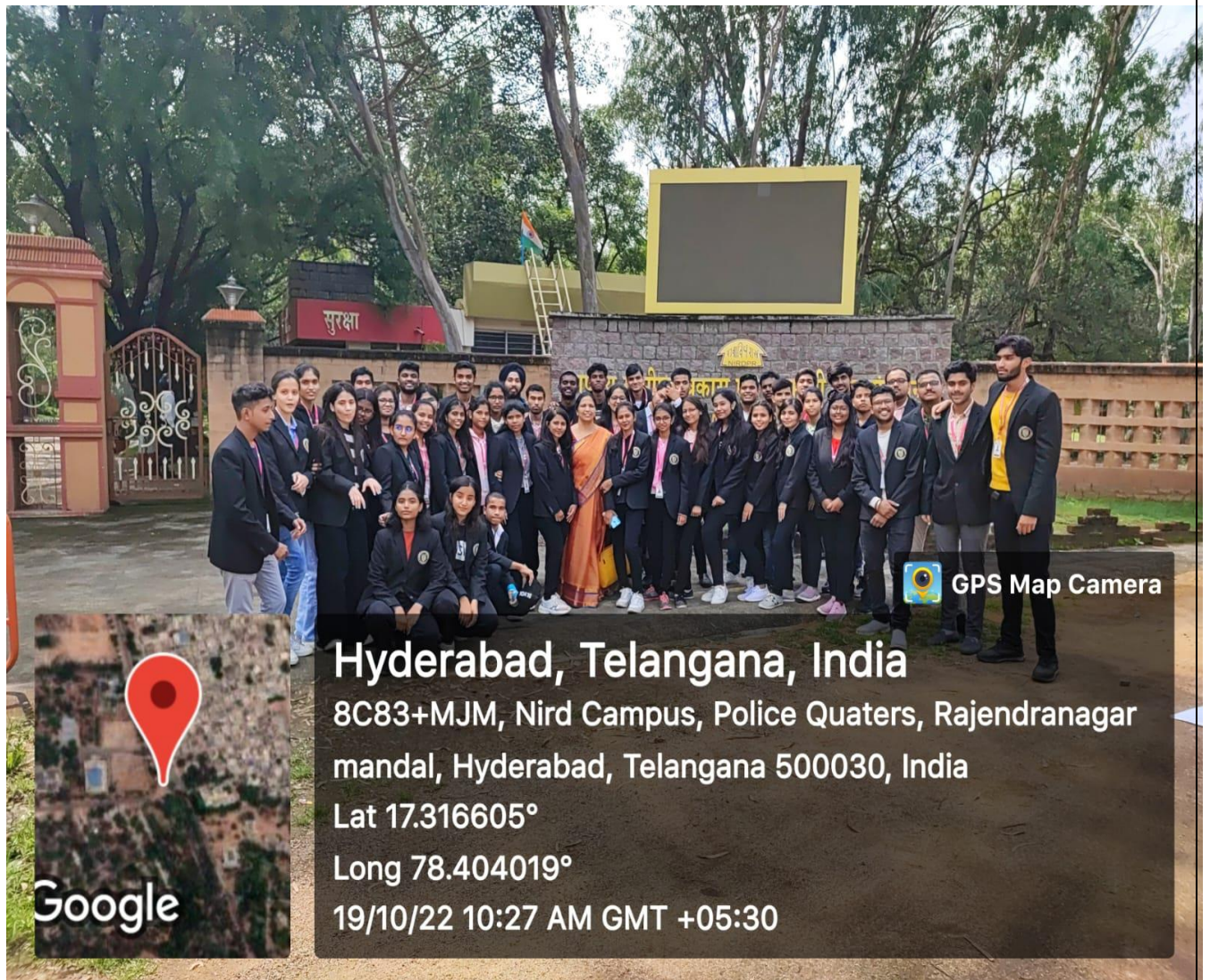

The day for B.com Honours 2nd year started with blessings of the father Dr Fr Sundar Reddy on 19th Oct, 2022. Then all the Honours students got assembled with the respective class in charge for the industrial trip i.e., Mrs. M. Padmaja. Then we all boarded for the bus to NIRD located in Rajendranagar, Hyderabad. It took around 50 minutes to reach the location. The ambience of the place was calm and peaceful. After fulfilling the security norms, the bus was permitted to enter inside. Then one of the NIRD speaker Dr. Pranab Kumar Ghosh gave an insight on the purpose of establishment of NIRD with PPT and showed various points of interest like mud houses which are used for water purification and also rainwater harvesting. And small video also was played which explained about all the plants working at NIRD. Students were taken to a paper mill where there were producing different types of colour papers which can be used for multiple uses like decoration, greeting cards and even making jewellery boxes. Then the students were shown that how does a portable biogas plant works. The functioning of the biogas plant was demonstrated by Ghosh sir. The biogas plant can be replaced today's modern day fuel to which can be used for preparing food. Then the students were up for lunch and then we were taken to organic shops where one can purchase many organic products including the pure honey which was available in variety of types. They were also other products available like organic soil which can be used for planting potted plants in house gardens.

Students showed lot of interest while observing various sustainable house models. They were keen in observing the typology house models and roofs with which they were made up of. They also felt excited observing the honey processing and how farmers generate money with innovation in honey processing. Leaf plate, cup making handmade paper, herbal cosmetics, pearl jewellery and home based products were other exhibits in the centre where students could interact with the entrepreneurs and could frame problem statements.

The students also enjoyed the pleasant atmosphere of the gardens over there which was far away from the pollution of the city. Overall, the weather of the day was pleasant although there was a slight rainfall in the afternoon. Then students were departed from there by 3:00PM and reached the college by 4:30PM. This industrial trip also gave many innovative ideas which will help the students to become budding entrepreneurs.
