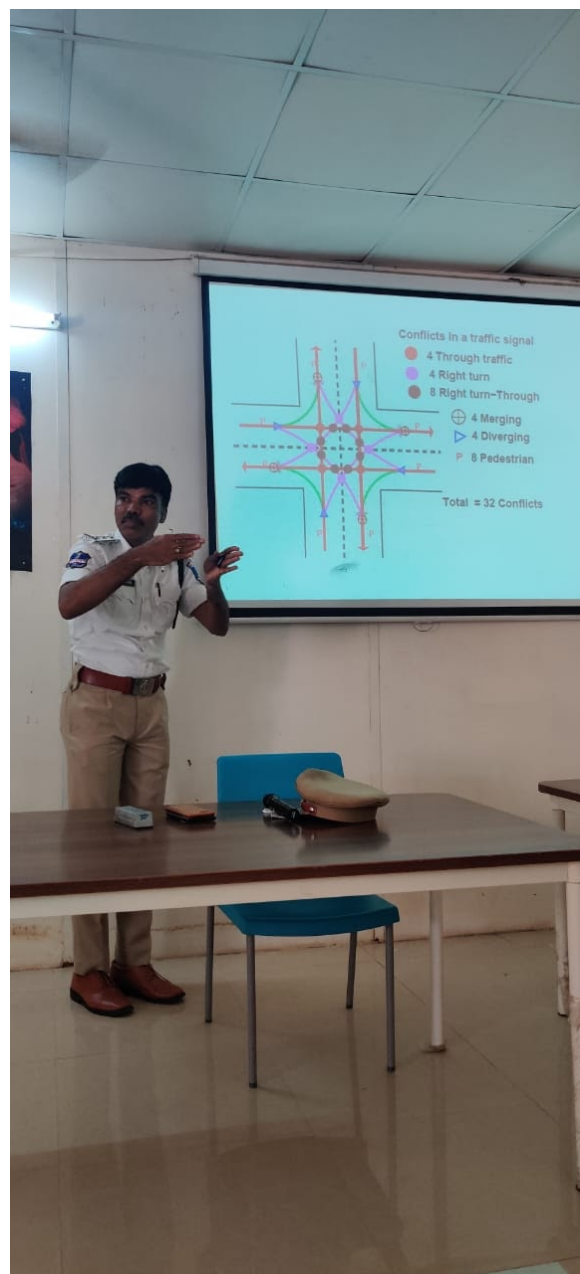
Venue: Cyberabad Police Commissionerate

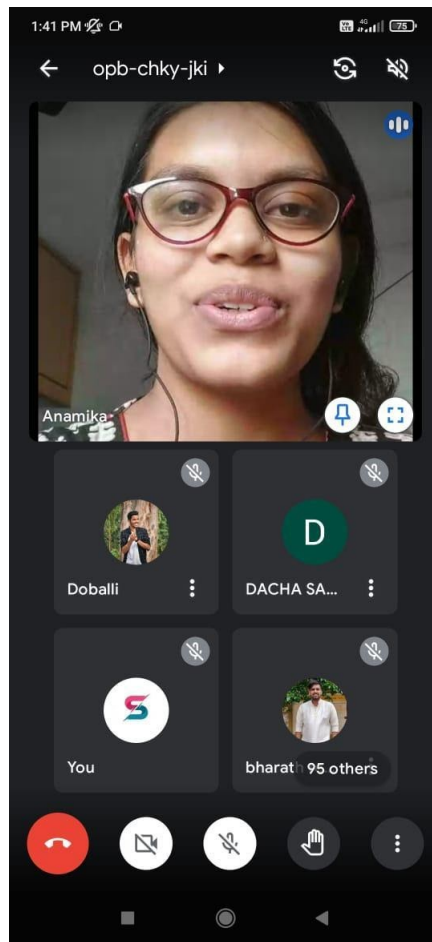
