
REPORT ON LITERARY EVENTS CONDUCTED BY TELUGU STUDENTS


DEPARTMENT OF SECOND LANGUAGES (Telugu)-ST. JOPSEPH'S DEGREE AND PG COLLEGE:


1. Telugu Bhasha Dinotsavam-2021 (Telugu Language Day- August 29 2021.):

29th2021 August marked the 158thbirth anniversary of the renown Telugu scholar and reformer of the Telugu Language- Gidugu Venkata Ramamurthy Panthulu. Till the late 19th century, the language spoken by people and the language written in the literary works were not same. The language in literary works, referred to as "Grandhika Bhasha", was taught in schools. Many colleges couldn't provide education to converse in this scholarly language. As a consequence, scholarship was restricted only to the ones able to understand the incomprehensible Grandhika Bhasha. Gidugu Venkata Ramamurthy Panthulu worked with contemporary linguists like Gurajada Apparao, P.T. Srinivas Iyengar and J.A. Yates to revolutionize and reform Telugu into a comprehensible "Vyaavahaarika Bhasha". Though it was not accepted by many Pandits (Scholars) who feared this movement may defame the existing language, the visionary idea of scholars like Gidugu, Gurajada paved the way to reform Telugu Language. Gidugu dedicated his life to educate people to write in a simple language that they use to converse. With the help of the government, Gidugu issued a G.O stating students can write exams in either of the languages (Grandhika or Vyaavahaarika) in 1912. Many conferences were held between 1915 to 1940 in places like Kakinada, Rajamahendravaram, Tanuku where Vyaavahaarika Telugu language was idolized. As a result, Kakinada's Andhra Sahitya Parishad officially started to communicate using Vyaavahaarika language. Many illiterate students were able to understand and communicate using the Vyaavahaarika bhasha, which was patronized by Gidugu. Gurajada's Kanyashulkam created a huge response in supporting literary works in Vyaavahaarika Telugu. Gidugu established many newspapers and monthly magazines that used Vyaavahaarika Telugu language. Telugu, Pratibha are few magazines and Varthamana Andhra Bhasha Pravarthaka Samajam (Society to Initiate Contemporary Telugu Language) was established in 1919 under theleadership of Gidugu. Being influenced by Gidugu, Taapi Dharma rao started 'Janavaani' magazine in 1937 that used Vyaavahaarika language.

Commemorating the services rendered by visionary Gidugu Venkata Ramamurthy Panthulu, the Telugu students of St. Joseph's Degree and PG college conducted an online conference where students discussed the importance of Telugu Language and famous works in the language. Students expressed their opinion about the differences of the language and Graandhika Language works of Pothana, Dhurjati were discussed simultaneously with Vyaavahaarika Language works of Baddena(Sumathi Shatakam). Telugu Lecturer Ms. Ananthalakshmi expressed the importance of comprehensible language as a medium of conversation. Some pictures of the event include:








2. Telangana Bhasha Dinotsavam-2021(Telangana Language Day- September 9-2021.):

In 2014, The Telangana State government announced to celebrate Telangana Bhasha Dinotsavam annually on September 9, marking the 100th birth anniversary of Telangana's icon Kaloji Narayana Rao. Kaloji Narayana Rao was a Telugu poet hailing from Telangana's Telugu speaking region. Kaloji's works were influenced by the contemporary movements which included the annexation of Hyderabad Nizam into Indian union in 1948. Kaloji believed that pen is mightier than a sword and his works reflect his belief. Kaloji worked with contemporary leaders and linguists like Maadapati Hanumantha Rao, Suravaram Prathapa Reddy, Boorgula Ramakrishna Rao and P.V. Narasimha Rao in many movements and protests. As a student Kaloji condemned Nizam's rule and celebrated Ganesha Chavithi and was banned from the city when he tried to hoist the Indian flag in the Warangal Fort. Kaloji helped students who were expelled from the Osmania university as they were participating in the Indian Freedom Struggle by sending them to the Nagpur university. Kaloji openly opposed Nizam rule in Hyderabad state and organized conferences with the help of Andhra Saraswatha Parishad to protest against the ridiculous rule of Razakars. He served as the Vice President for the Telangana Writers Association and as a member of the legislative council for one term. The Indian Government conferred him with the Padma Vibhushan award in 1992. Kaloji was affectionately addressed as Praja Kavi (People's Poet) by the people of Telangana. Kaloji strongly wanted everyone to write their works in their own dialect of Telugu. He believed that spoken language is always better than language learnt in schools. Kaloji dreamt every village to have a library was active in the library movement across India. He expired on November 13th 2002.

Remembering Kaloji's love and care towards the oppressed people, the Telugu students of St. Joseph's conducted a virtual event on his 107th birth anniversary. Kaloji's life, struggle, contribution to the language, leadership skills and many qualities were discussed on the platform by the students. Students expressed their views of writing Telugu in the dialect they use to speak. Kaloji's works like Naa Godava (My Pandemonium) were talked about and his opinion of using English instead of Telugu and local languages was also discussed. 


