## REPORT ON 2<sup>nd</sup> INDUSTRY ACADEMIA MEETING

The Department of Mathematics & Statistics has organized the 2<sup>nd</sup> Industry Academia Meeting on 23<sup>rd</sup> February'2023 in the Jubilee hall, St. Joseph's Degree & PG College at 2PM. The main objective of the meeting was to join the hands with Industry, to know the Industry needs for the employability of the students, and ensure that the student's skills are developed by designing the curriculum Industry friendly, also in par with the New Education Policy, NEP.

The Principal Fr.Dr. D. Sunder Reddy addressed the meeting and threw light on the objective of the Industry Academia meeting and thanked the resource persons for their presence.

Mr. D. Srinivas Reddy, HoD has presented the B. Sc (MPCs/MECs/MSCs) Course structures. The resource persons have reviewed the syllabus, Dr. Bivudutta Mishra has strongly recommended to make the student perform problem solving which would help them to improve and develop their skills in analysing the question and various ways to solve it. He also stated that this will help the student to understand the practical approach for any given problem and live projects. This would help the student to get placed in the Industry.

The BSc Statistics (MSCS) course structures were presented by Mrs.S.Vijayalaxmi; thereby the discussion with regards to the syllabus took place. The team suggested no changes in the statistics syllabus.

# Minutes of the meeting:

- 1. The meeting started at 2.00PM in the Jubilee started then followed by the prayer by the principal Fr. Dr. D. Sunder Reddy
- 2. Mr. D. Srinivas Reddy, Head of the department welcome the resources persons and introduced the department members
- 3. Mrs. S.Vijayalaxmi presented the previous meeting minutes which was held on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
- 4. Mr.D. Srinivas Reddy presented the syllabus of mathematics papers of all the Semesters including SEC papers
- 5. Mr.Bivudatta Mishra highlighted the practical's of semester-III paper 'Real Analysis' and semester-IV paper 'Algebra' that instead of practical's for both the papers students can have tutorial classes for theory concepts
- 6. Prof. Bivudutta Mishra also asked about the number of different mathematics papers in all the semesters

- 7. Prof. Bivudutta Mishra also suggested to have some elective papers to the students with the combination of Mathematics, Statistics or Computer Science or Data Science
- 8. Mr.D.Srinivas Reddy highlighted the implementation of new course as MSDS(Mathematics, Statistics, Data Science)
- 9. Prof. Bivudutta suggested to implement B.Sc (Data science) instead of the course 'MSDS'
- 10. Prof. Jagan Mohan suggested to implement the course like MES (Mathematics, Economics, Statistics) also one more course like B.Sc(Double or Triple Mathematics) like Mathematics ,Applied mathematics, Statistics etc.
- 11. Mr. Anjan Kumar Kalva, Managing Director of CRO clinicalmapletree Analytics ,Pvt ltd suggested to have more practical orientation of all the papers
- 12. Mr. Anjan Kumar Kalva also suggested that the syllabus should not be taught for examinations purpose instead more theoretic concepts to be taught using practical orientation
- 13. Mr. Anjan Kumar also suggested to inculcate the industry related topics in the curriculum
- 14. Prof. Bivudutta Mishra suggested to have relation with industry to make students expertise in the subject
- 15. Prof. Bivudutta suggested to maintain the course plane for each hour along with reference link of the text book prescribed in the syllabus
- 16. Mr. D.Srinivas Reddy asked for some suggestions on Projects, MoU's etc
- 17. Prof. Bivudutta also suggested to have one 'Industry Guide' for final year for their projects. Sir suggested 'ONGC',CCMB,CR Rao institute etc for projects MoU's
- 18. Prof.Bivudutta suggested to inculcate the concept of integral transforms in integral calculus for projects in Mathematics
- 19. Prof. Jagan Mohan suggested to implement 'Stock Market Analysis' as a certificate course
- 20. Members also suggested to have bifurcation of hours for the certificate courses to particular domains
- 21. Mr. Anjan Kumar suggested to implement Bio-Statistics in pharma
- 22. Members also suggested to have certification in cryptography in Number Theory
- 23. Also suggested to have 6 to 8 weeks of internship after the semester IV
- 24. Suggested to inculcate interdisciplinary concepts into the syllabus
- 25. Suggested to inculcate algorithm-based curriculum to be implemented
- 26. Suggested to implement Calculus subject for Economics students as a generic elective
- 27. Suggested to have workshops on SAS along with BSc (MSCs)

- 28. Suggested to implement 'Bio statistics' as a Diploma course
- 29. Suggested to implement 'Mathematica' Software for practical orientation
