A Candidate seeking admission into the MBA programme must satisfy the following criteria:

- Must possess graduate/equivalent Degree from Osmania University or other recognized University in any discipline with 50% marks in aggregate.
- The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination (10+2+3) or equivalent on the date of admission with "Mathematics" as one of the subjects in SSC for admission into MBA.
- Seventy percent (70%) seats are filled through University common ICET counseling. The seat shall be filled on the basis of rank obtained in ICET in that particular year or on the basis of rank obtained in All India Common Entrance Test
- The candidate should be of Indian National. Must be eligible for the admission as per the rules of the Government of TS, with regard to local/non-local status, etc and other rules in force.
- The other 30% is filled by the Management under the Management quota. For admissions under Management Quota the student should be qualified in ICET.
- NRI & NRI sponsored seats (15% of Management quota) shall be filled with candidates who
 have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% of aggregate / group subjects
 or cumulative grade point average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a scale of 10.
- The left over seats shall be filled on merit basis by the Management of the Institution with candidates from other States and Union Territories of India who have passed the qualifying examination and secured rank in any All India Common Entrance Test (AICET).
- The vacant seats if any shall be filled with eligible candidates including those securing not less than 50% marks in aggregate or in group subjects in the qualifying examination duly ensuring merit and transparency

- The students will obtain Two Credits (2 Credits) on the completion of one MOOCs Course with a duration of "8 Weeks" and above from Swayam Portal.
- The credits for Swayam Course will be allotted in the fourth semester of MBA Program and will reflect in the Consolidated Marks Memo (CMM) along with the regular academic credits.
- The award of Original Degree by the parent university will be given to the student though he/she does not complete the MOOCs courses.
- The Swayam Online courses will be released in two timelines "January-April" and "July-December" every year.
- St. Joseph's PG College is a Swayam Local Chapter (3022) of Swayam-NPTEL platform that coordinates with all the students in order to pursue the courses from the Swayam platform in the two timelines.
- All the students are advised to complete the Swayam Certification by the end of second semester.
- The students enrolled for the Swayam course will get regular guidance, coordination, communication, and mentorship by the team of SJC Local Chapter (MOOCs Committee) till the completion of courses.
- We encourage the students to choose the Swayam Course from various disciplines to acquire multidisciplinary knowledge.
- The Students will obtain Two credits on the completion of one certificate course (minimum 30 hours)
