

Name of the Event : Clean & Functioning of rest rooms

Objective of the Event:

The objective of the event was to know the cleanliness and functioning of the girls and boys rest rooms in the campus.

Report:

As a part of social responsibility the student of Joseph's Social Responsibility committee organized a program on Sanitation and hygiene in the main campus. The registered students of JSR were divided into groups and were asked to inspect the clean and functioning of girls and boys rest rooms in the campus.

The following were the problems noticed by the students:

Girl's rest rooms:

A group of 4 girls with a team of 2 each were assigned to inspect the girls rest rooms and the following problems were identified by the students.

- ❖ Tap of the washbasin is neither clean nor working.
- No proper electricity (lights are not working properly).
- Should provide hand wash for hygiene preferably paper soaps.

- ❖ In one of the wash room the Sanitary pad machine is not working and in one the wash room there is no sanitary pad machine.
- One of the washrooms doesn't have a dustbin.
- ❖ Dustbins are not tidy (like pads and other garbage is not thrown out)

Boys rest rooms:

- ❖ There were no barriers between the drinking water point and washrooms.
- ❖ In one the washrooms the flushes were not working.
- The ventilators of the wash rooms are formed with lot of dust.
- ❖ In the washroom the water was leaking from the taps and also they found some broken drain pipes, broken taps in the washrooms.

The students have given some of the following suggestions:

- To construct the barrier between the drinking water point and washrooms.
- ❖ To fix the doors to the wash rooms and also to provide lights.
- To provide the hand wash in the rest rooms.
- To provide the dust bins in all the washrooms.
- To provide with sanitary pads machines in all the girls restrooms.

Outcome:

The students actively participated in the survey and collected the data by inspecting the washrooms in the campus and the required suggestions were given.

- Some of the boys are chewing the pans in bottles and keeping them in the classrooms.


Outcome:
