Minutes of the IQAC Advisory Committee Meeting -2023-23. 17 February 2023

Agenda Point 01: The IQAC meeting began on an auspicious note as Mrs. Vinayasheela, Dean, Academics, invoked the God's blessings to prevail upon the IQAC members to steer the college towards Quality enhancement and sustenance.

Agenda Point 02: Prof.Danam Tressa, IQAC Coordinator, welcomed the members with a sapling and gave a formal introduction of the members, followed by a formal welcome address delivered by Principal, Fr.Dr.D. Sunder Reddy, who highlighted the critical significance of the synergy generated by the IQAC Meeting in review and renewal of existing mechanisms in paving the way for Quality Enhancement of Academic and Administrative processes of the college for the Integrated Development of Students and society at large.

Agenda Point 03: This was followed by the Principal's presentation of the Agenda of the meeting, which was unanimously approved by the members.

Agenda Point 04: Dr.Sreelatha, Head, Department of Commerce, presented the minutes of the previous IQAC Meeting, which was approved by the members unanimously.

Agenda Point 05: This was followed by the Action Taken Report presented by the IQAC Coordinator, who elaborated on the implementation of relevant suggestions made by the members at the previous year IQAC Meeting conducted in April 2022.

Professor P.L. Visveshwara Rao added that the previous IQAC Member's suggestion to include Research Methodology in the curriculum was followed up by including topics like 'Plagiarism Law, Rules and Regulations' into the Mass Communication curriculum.

Agenda Point 06: The Presentation, given by the IQAC Coordinator, which followed, gave an overview of the college activities conducted during the academic year 2022-23 highlighting the contribution of IQAC in taking up quality initiatives for the holistic development of the students.

Agenda Point 07: The Principal sought approval and ratification of AQAR submitted by the institution for the year 2020-21, which met with a unanimous approval by the members.


Agenda Point 08: Mrs.Kiran Jyothi, HoD, Department of Computer Science, gave insights into initiatives taken by the college to orient students and faculty towards Academic Bank of Credits and being successful in making 45 percent of students to open digilockers and how credits earned through Swayam will be reflected in National Academic Depository.

This was followed by Mrs. Vinaya Sheela, Dean, Academics, presenting information about Non-Credit Courses Introduced by the Institution in the Academic Year 2022- 2023. The presentation highlighted the different Value Added Courses which aimed at learning a new skill or enhancing a new skill to widen the scope of conventional education. Thereby, the committee was invited to give further suggestions on the effective implementation of Non-Credit Courses.

Prof Sireesha, IQAC Director, OU, expressed a view that the Non-Credit Courses being highly beneficial for the students should be allotted credits. In response to this suggestion, Mrs.Vinaya Sheela stated that giving credits to Non-Credit Courses would pose the problem of exceeding the set norm for total credits for each program.

Mrs.Vinaya Sheela further spoke about the prospect of introducing Diploma Courses in the upcoming Academic Year and the Principal reinforced the need for Diploma Courses in view of meeting the requirement of a 4 year Degree Program as per NEP 2020 Guideline.

Ms.Mariyam Fatima, Alumni Representative, responded, saying that the Alumni of the college would benefit immensely if they are allowed to join Diploma Courses even after they leave the college. She reinforced the critical need for drafting crisp and effective resume.



OACICO aph's Dec Ms.Fathima also highlighted the importance of grooming the students in corporate etiquette for better employability.

The Alumni representative also emphasised Writing blogs by collaborating with Media house to increase their visibility as there is growing demand for creative skills and content Writing.

Mr. Tapas Shah, Parent Representative, recorded a high note of appreciation for the excellent progress made by the college in all areas, which was evident in the Qualitative Administration and Academic practices of the college. He accorded high praise for giving Students Knowledge, skills and a nurturing environment and numerous career opportunities of high order.

Mr. Tapas also drew attention to the growing job opportunities and research projects available in Pharma industry. He has urged faculty to apply for research grants and leverage platforms like Pharma patashala.

Prof.Sirisha suggested that the Institution should leverage its MOU with MSME to avail 15 day training program with Government certification. Even Faculty can go for industry collaboration for undertaking consultancy work. To this Prof. Vandana Samba responded, saying that already students are doing internship of one and half months, under NIMSME in Collaboration with our Institution.

Mr.Tapas reinforced the critical need to educate the students on Environmental Sustainability. Dr.Sangeetha, HoD, Department of English informed the members of the Environmental Studies Course which is made mandatory for the students, adding that sir can give his expert guidance for including topics on Sustainability in the EVS syllabus.

Prof.Sirisha reiterated the need for following the UGC Model framework syllabus and also equip the faculty by conducting workshops on revised curriculum

Mr. Tapas also highlighted the growing importance of Psychology in the industry, particularly students with Psychology background having a great prospects for HR recruitments.

Mr.Glen D'Souza, HoD, Dept of Mass.Communication presented a report he field trips and internships conducted in the year 22-23.


Prof.Sirisha, IQAC Director, OU, suggested that WhatsApp groups with Alumni, will help in tracking student progression.
