





### **About Programme:**

The program was initiated by Mrs Aparna Rajhans, coordinator who gave a brief introduction about library and Knowledge enhancement and its necessity for current situations. Dr. S. Venkata Siva Kumar, Associate Professor & CoE, PGDM, introduced the In house Guest resource persons of the day.

The key factors highlighted by the Resource persons are as follows:

# 1. Mr. Jyothi Kalyan, Assistant Professor, DBM

The talk is about usage of digital resources available at the institution level. These resources are available for both faculty and the student's equally. The resource is available through N-List. An initiative of government of India to improve the access of individuals to the most valuable resources which are not available for all.

These services are given through institution library. Each individual will be registered on this digital platform through college library and the credentials are shared to them on their registered email ID (official mail IDs) through N-List, we can accesses thousands of journals and E-Books for free of cost.

We can also download them and save them on our pc/laptop/mobile phone for future access. If we wish to get a printed copy of any book which is of high cost, we can use the service of DELNET. Through DELNET we not only read the digital resources, but we can get a printed copy which can be couriered to the registered address of the college.

This service is available only through membership and our college is having membership with DELNET. Those who wish to get a copy of the book they can approach the librarian and raise a request. The best part of it is that they don't charge any amount on rental except that to and fro postal charges are to be paid for the book requested.

The resource person Mr.Kalyan explained about the advantages of using N-List and DELNET and process of accessing it online.

### 2. A Joel, Central Data Systems, St. Joseph's Degree & PG College

Mr. Joel demonstrated the process of accessing the digital resources online and demonstrated some examples of how to use and access the digital resources through N-List

- N-List Member Login procedure.
- ➤ List of e-Journals & e-Books
- Procedure / steps to search for e-journals & e-books
- > Search criteria 1) Book Title 2) Category wise 3) Subject wise 4) Book Author 5) Citation.
  - Viewing/ saving/ Print/ Download steps of books / journals.
- > Things to remember while downloading the e-books / e-journals & Delnet Member Login Procedure
- Search procedure for viewing / downloading of e-books or e-journals Two option of getting the e-books / e-journals 1) view/ download 2) Rent a book (physical copy)
- Procedure and steps to follow on how to rent a physical book from the source. Informed about the User Login and User Activity report & Login time and date, No. of times logged in and No. of pages viewed are recorded.

At the end Mr. Joel demonstrated the same on internet showing how we can request for a book from DELNET. Mr. Henry and Mr. Joel explained about how the accreditation agencies tracts our usage of digital resources online using N-List website. Further aappealed / informed to contact the Librarian for any concerns or questions.

At the outset I (M. Sravan Kumar) extend my sincere heartfelt thanks to Principal Fr. Dr. D. Sunder Reddy for encouraging and motivating all faculties to enter a new level of using the library resources and relevant softwares. Thanks to Dr. S.
