Report:

The Department of Second Languages organized its first Industry Academia Meet on January 20, 2024. The primary focus of the meet was to discuss on the various issues in language learning and Teaching and what more could be done to ensure that the syllabus and courses offered met the industrial requirements. Also in focus was the introduction of specific purpose or need based diploma / certificate courses. This was followed by a brief introduction of the resource persons and individual presentations. The sequence followed was: Arabic, French Hindi, Sanskrit and Telugu. Each resource person gave his/her perspective on the respective language scenario in the education and

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industry level and how the gap between both can be reduced. Effective Language Teaching and Learning through innovation and student teacher collaboration was another major theme and given the fact that Languages are not considered as career options, ideas were shared as to how to make languages more interesting and attractive to the students.

Outcome and Conclusion: Lots of interesting ideas were shared which could cater to all the languages offered by the department. Some of the takeaways were:

- Inclusion of the languages in all the six semesters or addition of classes in the existing time-table
- Incorporating and imparting human and moral values, professional ethics, environment and sustainability in the curriculum
- More focus on oral communication.
- Identification of Local, Regional, National and Global needs and make adjustments in syllabus to meet those needs.
- Research oriented learning through faculty-student co-operation.
- Incorporating and imparting Gender sensitivity.
- Introduction of Courses in Translation, Communication (Level wise) as well language for specific purposes: Hospitality, Media and commercial.

The presentation and discussion session was followed by a Valedictory session where the guests were felicitated and the event concluded with a formal vote of thanks.


Reports:







Arabic is the language of 22 of the Member States of UNESCO and is one of the Organization's official languages. It is one of the most widespread languages spoken by more than 422 million people; most of them live in the Middle East and North Africa.


