

# **GUIDELINES OF GENERIC ELECTIVE**

## **Generic Elective (GE) Course**

An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, and has the objective of broadening the academic experience of a student with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective.

The purpose of this category of papers is to offer the students the option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in Core and Discipline Specific Elective papers.

The lists provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each department has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need.

### **Note:**

- \* A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/department and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective.
- \* The College may offer any number of choices of papers from different disciplines under Generic Elective as per the availability of the courses/faculty.

## **Guidelines for Generic Elective (GE) w.e.f 2024 - 2025**

1. Generic Electives are a pool of courses meant to provide multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary education to students.
2. A student taking admission in any undergraduate course is required to study a General Elective (GE) Course in the Vth semester.
3. GE Courses will be offered to Students of other Department/ Programmes
4. These courses are offered by various disciplines of study (excluding the GEs offered by the parent discipline), from which a student can choose.
5. Student cannot select / opt for Generic elective course belonging to core course or his/her own subject

6. The students are required to select the GE option through Google form circulated by the college in advance to their College email id only.
7. College reserves the right to allocate GE options to the students other than the first preference.
8. The student will not be permitted to change the options/preferences once submitted & allotted under any circumstances.
9. Students who will not abide by the deadline of selecting the GE option through Google form, will be allotted GE by the college as per the availability.
10. A GE course is offered only if a viable number of students opt for it. Further, the College reserves the right to
  - Restrict choices of GEs for a stream of students
  - Change the number of options offered and the paper, within the framework of the college
11. The minimum number of students in an Elective is 20. The maximum number of students in an Elective is 60.
12. The students will be allotted the best possible preference on a "First Come First Get" basis.
13. Generic Elective carries 4 Credits. GE Hours per week for preparing timetable are for Theory Courses ( 3 Lecture & 1 Tutorial Hour) and Practical Course ( 3 Lecture & 2 Practical Hours)
14. Generic Elective Evaluation pattern is 40 CIA & 60 ESA of 3 hour Exam like all DSE Courses
