UNIT-2: Definition and functions of research design; Types of research design (Longitudinal, Cross-sectional, Cohort, Trend studies, Focus groups, Blind studies, Placebo design, case study and Action research); Methods of Data collection (Observation, Interview, Questionnaire); Collecting data using secondary sources; Selecting a sample (Concept of sampling, Principles and Types of sampling); Writing a research report as per APA Guidelines, 7th Manual.

Project will be assessed for i00 marks. (40 Int + 60 Ext)

Research Design & Methodology for the project will be arrived at from a Supervisor & Student interaction

Tests or experiments that are introduced in psychology will be identified to conduct the project on a sample. These will be identified based the areas of interest of teacher and The student will then make a final presentation at the end of the semester, which will be

evaluated by one internal examiner and one external examiner.
