- The Department of Psychology conducted its 3<sup>rd</sup> Industry Academia Meet on 13<sup>th</sup> February 2024, the meeting started with a prayer asking for God's blessings by Asst. Professor Shravya Saneev Merugu.
- 2. HoD Psychology, Mrs. Amthul Fathima welcomed the guests as Principal Rev. Fr. Anthony Sagayaraja facilitated the guests with saplings.
- 3. Mrs Amthul Fathima began presenting the syllabus to the panel and opened the table for discussion.
- 4. Social Psychology was the first paper which was discussed. Mrs. Swapna Jyothi Asst. Professor, Dept. of Psychology and Mrs. A Ashwini, HoD Dept. of Psychology, Nizam College suggested further unitization of the paper to create a more comprehensive flow for the syllabus. It was suggested that Unit 5 be added titled Cross-Cultural Studies in Social Psychology to incorporate Indian and Global trends in Social Psychology to the syllabus. And Social Psychology in India be removed from Unit 1. It was also suggested that the sub topic titled –Rumours and Propaganda be further elaborated on, on the lines of Psychological factor in rumours, need for propaganda and types and techniques for propaganda.
- 5. For Abnormal Psychology paper it was discussed that the 4<sup>th</sup> unit could include topics on Mental Health Advocacy such as mental health awareness and awareness about how to avail insurance and legalities around mental health. Dr. Virinchi Sharma, Consultant Psychiatrist, Manasa Nursing Home suggested that the curriculum should include topics such as neuro-biology, brain circuits, TMS magnetic stimulation and ketamine therapy for industry relevance. It was also suggested by Ms. Shravya Saneev and agreed upon by the panel that Ethics should be included in abnormal psychology. Dr Swathi Agarwal, Career Consultant & Psychologist, Gargi Knowledge

Solutions suggested that common elements in effective treatment, case history taking, maintaining of data, counselling values and approaches to therapy should also be introduced to the students. Dr. Vrinichi also suggested the addition of the topic Behavioural Addictions, sub topics mobile, media, gambling, person addiction.

- 6. It was suggested that Adolescent Psychology paper be further unitized into 5 units instead of 4. To create a separate unit covering topics around Physical development, sexual orientation, gender identity and morality. It was also discussed that Cyber Bullying and Effects of digital media on adolescence be added to the syllabus.
- 7. The panel also extensively discussed which elective papers would be the most beneficial to the students between Health, child, education, adolescent psychology.

8. The panel also encouraged the department to offer value added course spearheaded by internal faculty and suggested the following papers for the same

i.Health and Well-being

ii.Transactional Analysis

iii.Personality Development

iv.Stress Management

v.Emotional Development

vi.Relationship Management

vii.Mental Health and Men

viii. Gender Psychology

9. The panel also ideated on papers for PG Diploma and Diploma courses suggesting papers such as criminal law, criminal behaviour, Mental Health Law, Counselling Psychology.

10. The meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks presented by Ms. Shravya Saneev Merugu, Asst. Prof. Department Psychology.
