



She highlighted the procedures for monitoring and managing attendance, which are crucial for maintaining academic standards. Internal exams were another focal point. The speaker explained the scheduling, conducting, and grading of these exams, emphasizing their role in assessing students' progress throughout the semester. Finally, the session covered the Prajna Software, a tool integral to the college's administrative functions. Prof. Anitha demonstrated its uses, including managing student records, tracking attendance, and facilitating internal communication, thereby enhancing efficiency and transparency in academic operations. The program was well-received, equipping faculty with a comprehensive understanding of the college's regulations and tools to support their roles effectively.</p>

- Faculty equipped with thorough explanation of the interconnections between POs, PEOs, PSOs, and COs, emphasizing their significance in the curriculum development process.

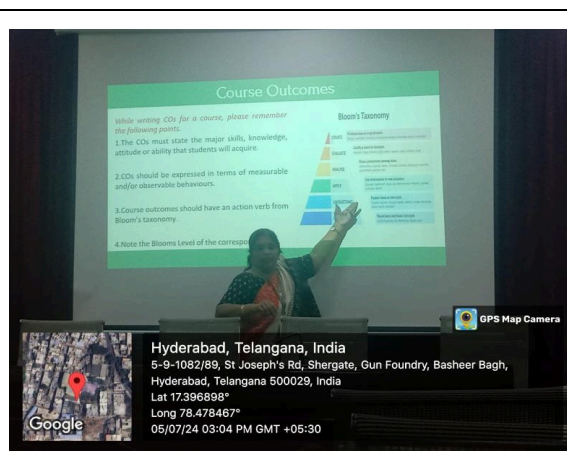
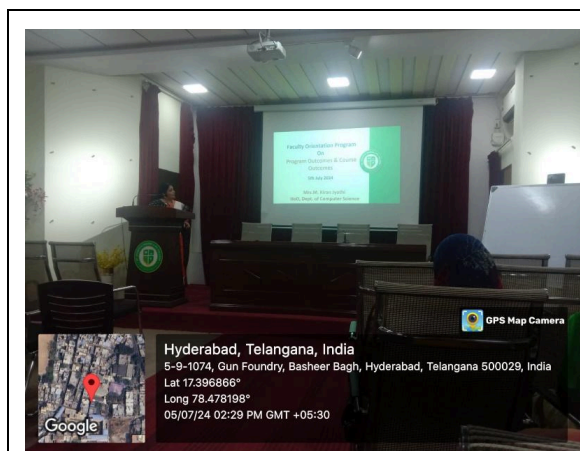
