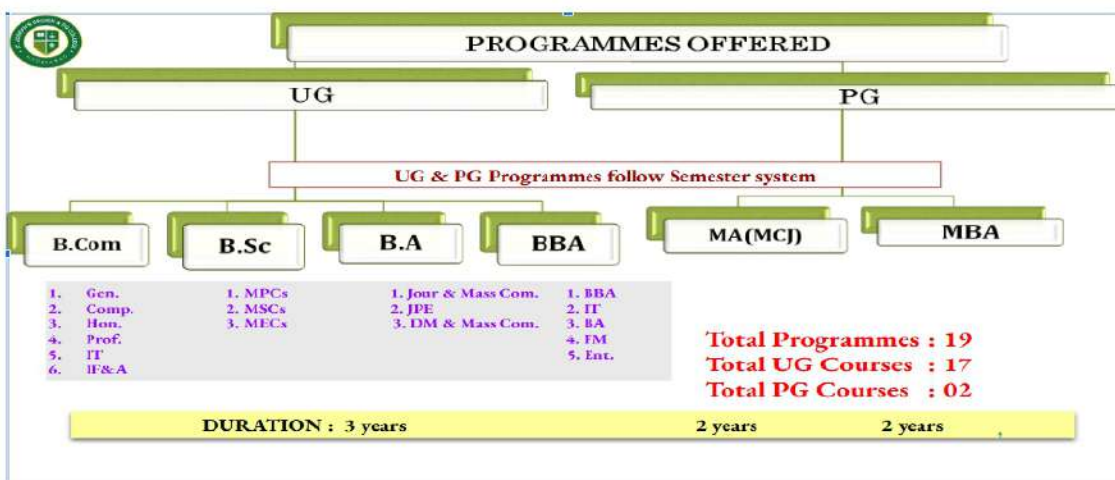

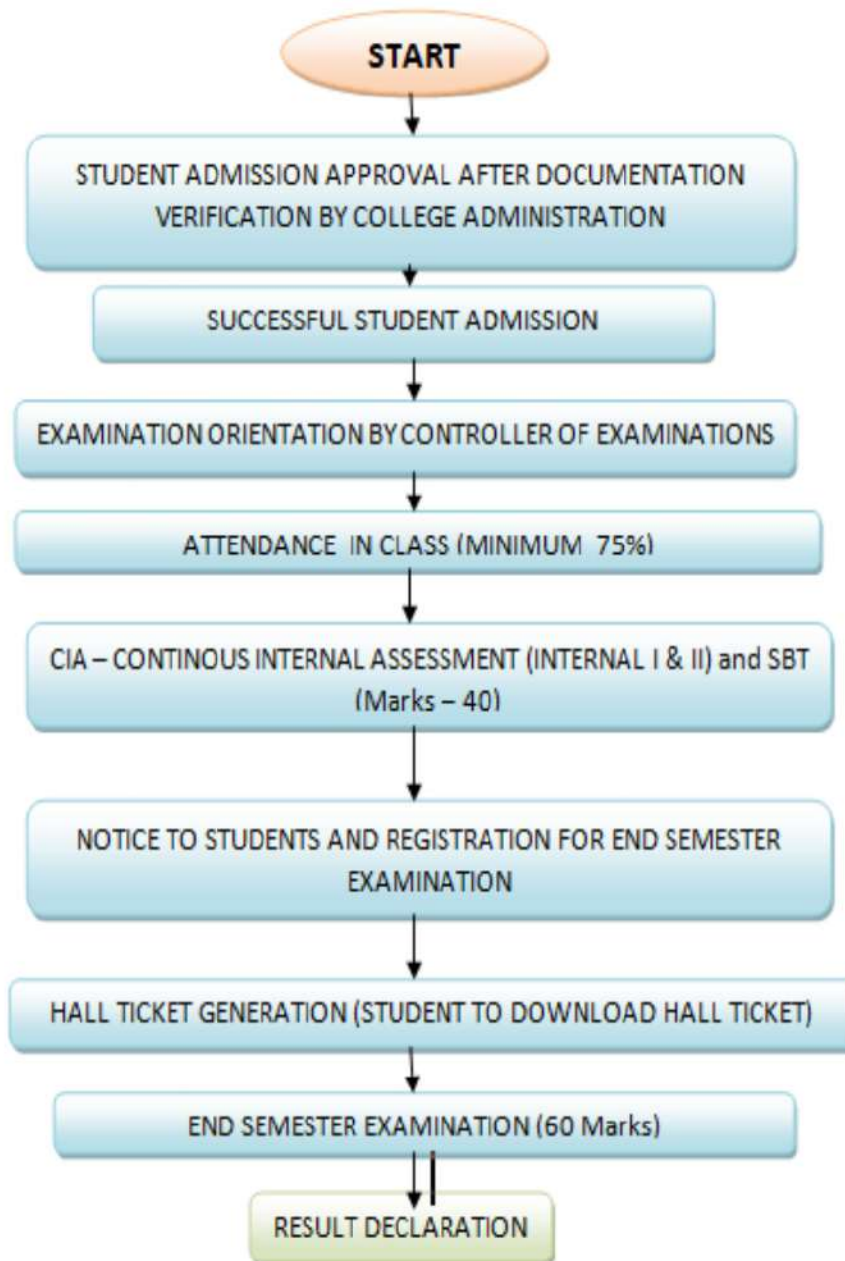

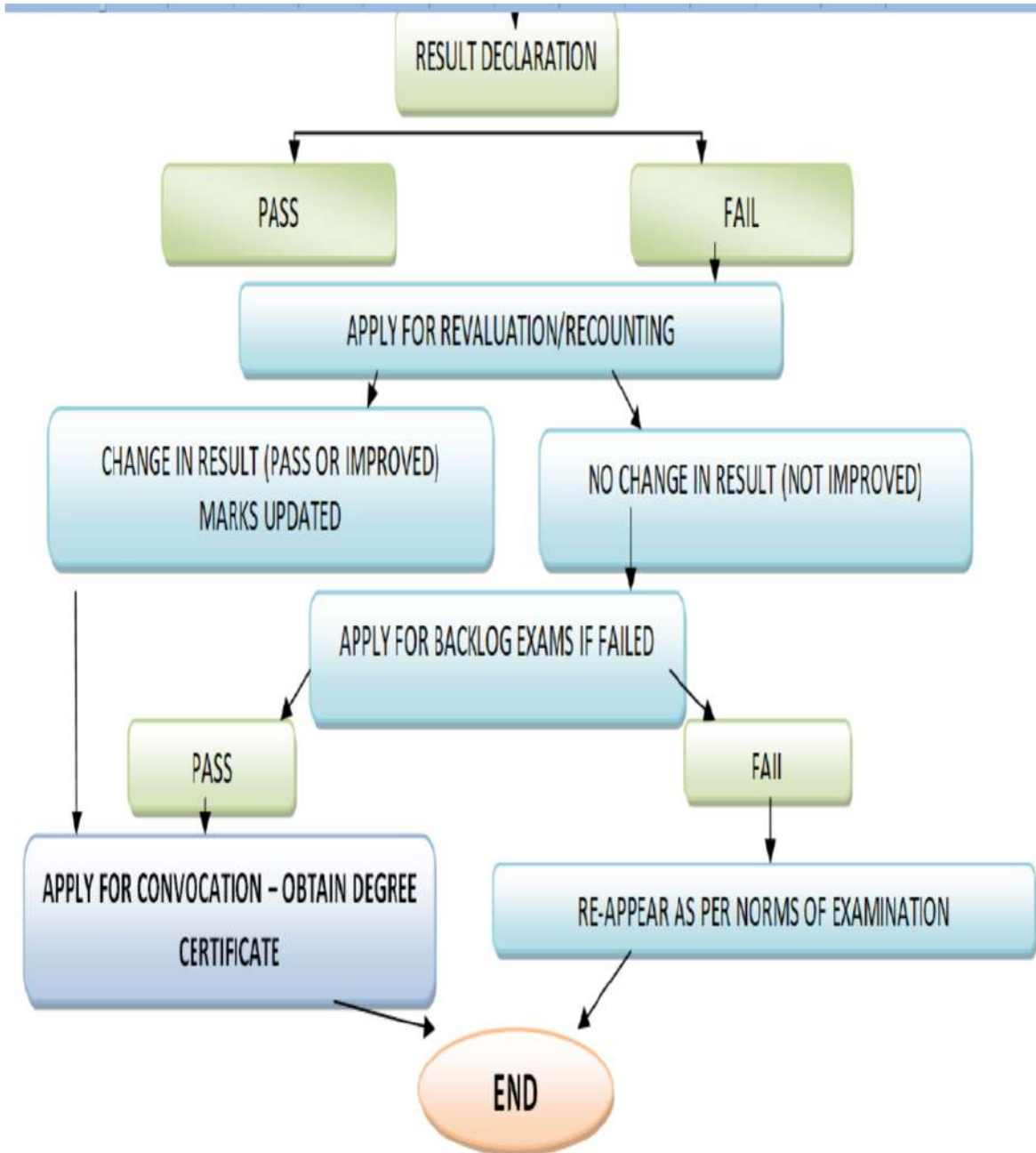
1. If the student has not submitted the examination application for the semester examinations due to any reason, He / She has to repeat the semester.
2. 75% attendance both in theory and practical courses (wherever applicable) is mandatory for candidates to be eligible to appear for the semester examination. All students who represent the College in inter-collegiate, inter-varsity, National and international competitions are eligible for attendance exemption of 8 weeks per year, that is, 4weeks per semester or the period of the competition, whichever is less. Examinations for I, III & V semesters are held in October / November each year after 15 weeks of instruction. There are no detentions at the end of I, III and V semesters. Examinations for II, V & VI semesters are held in March-April each year after 15 weeks of instruction. There is a detention system at the end of II and IV semesters.
3. Every student is required to complete His / Her course of study within 5 years from the date of admission, after which He / She will not be permitted to appear for any more examinations.

### PG MINI - CONVOCATION REPORT BATCH 2022-2024

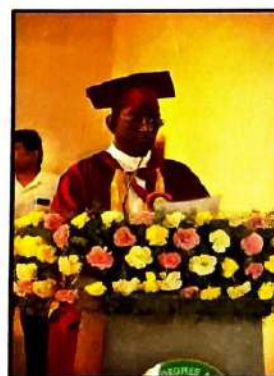
DATE: 08/10/2024
