# NOTICE TO PG (MA & MBA) STUDENTS

(IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS)

All Post Graduate students are required to adhere to the following guidelines **STRICTLY** for the upcoming even semester main examinations and Backlog examinations - MAY 2025.

### 1. Reporting Time

- a. Morning session: Students must be seated in the examination hall by 8:45 AM.
- b. Afternoon session: Students must be seated in the examination hall by 12:45 PM.
- c. Entrance checking will <u>commence at 8:35 AM for the morning session</u> and <u>12:35</u> PM for the afternoon session.
- d. No student is allowed strictly after the scheduled time.

#### 2. Permitted Items

- a. Students are allowed to carry only the required stationery like pen, pencil etc.., **color hall ticket**, and college ID card.
- b. Carrying any unauthorized/forbidden material will result in necessary action as per the examination rules.

#### 3. Hall Ticket Guidelines

- a. In case students forget their hall ticket, they must obtain a duplicate hall ticket by paving a fee of Rs. 200/-.
- b. Students must verify their hall ticket to ensure that the correct examination dates are printed as per the timetable. Any discrepancies should be reported immediately to the Controller of Examinations.

#### 4. Backlog Students

- a. Backlog students must refer to the backlog timetable available on the college website.
- b. For any clarifications, students are instructed to visit the Examination Branch.
- c. No re-examination will be conducted for missed backlog exams

## 5. General

- **a.** Any omission or clash of courses may be intimated to the Controller of examination, St. Joseph's Degee & PG College.
- b. The responsibility of obtaining correct question paper from the invigilator at the Examination hall rests with the candidate. Answering a wrong question paper may lead to cancellation of results.
